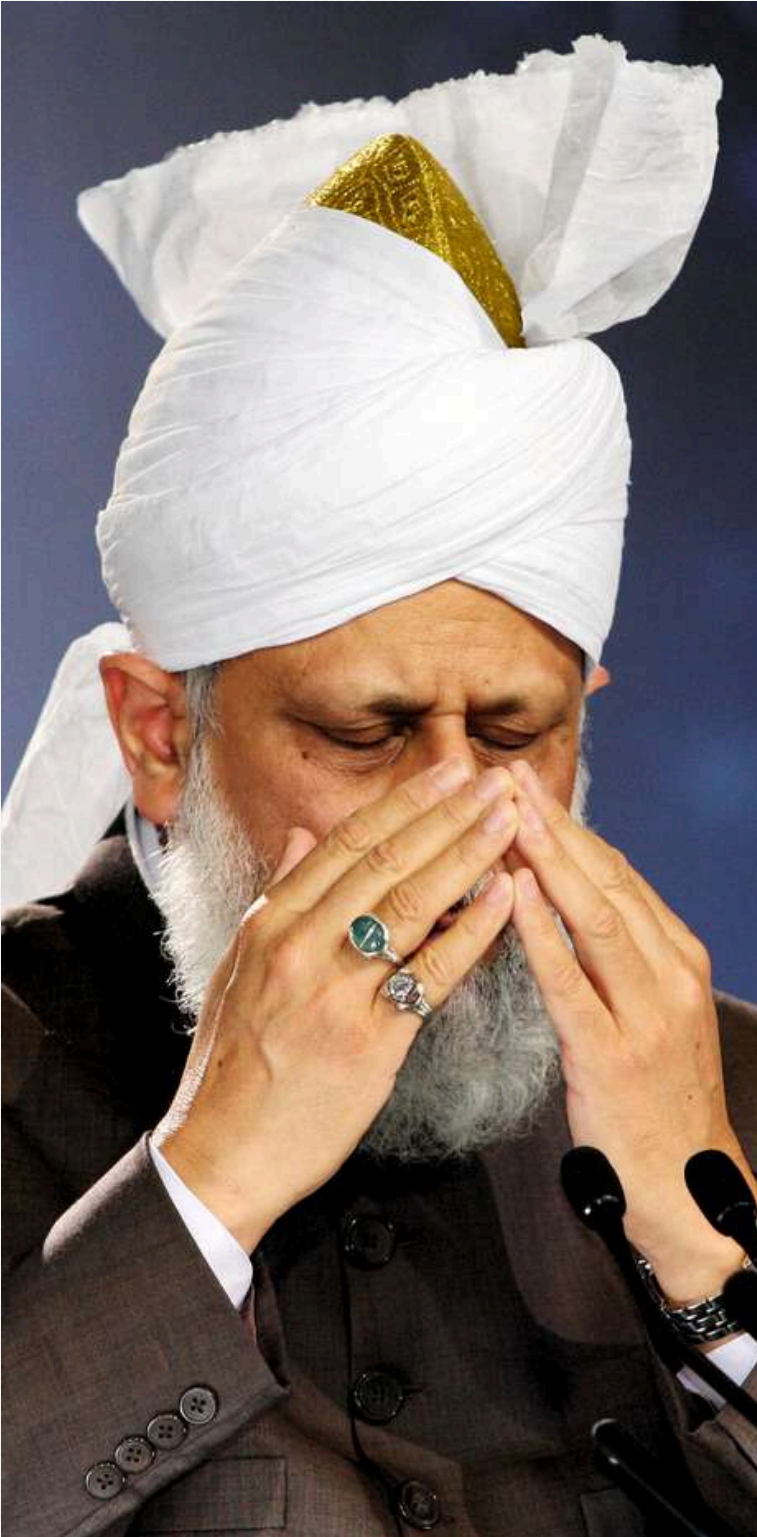

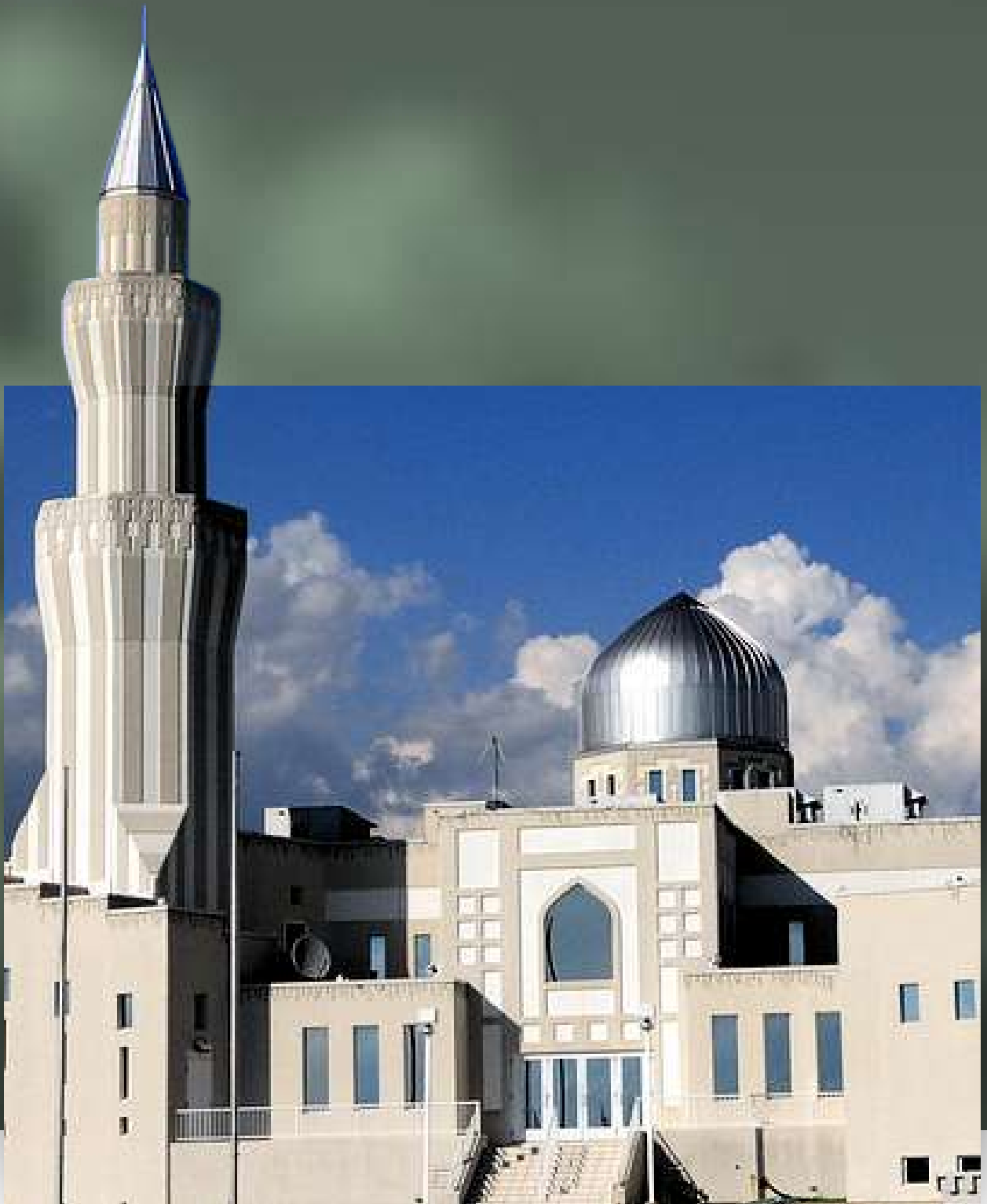

## 35TH MKAC NATIONAL IJTIMA

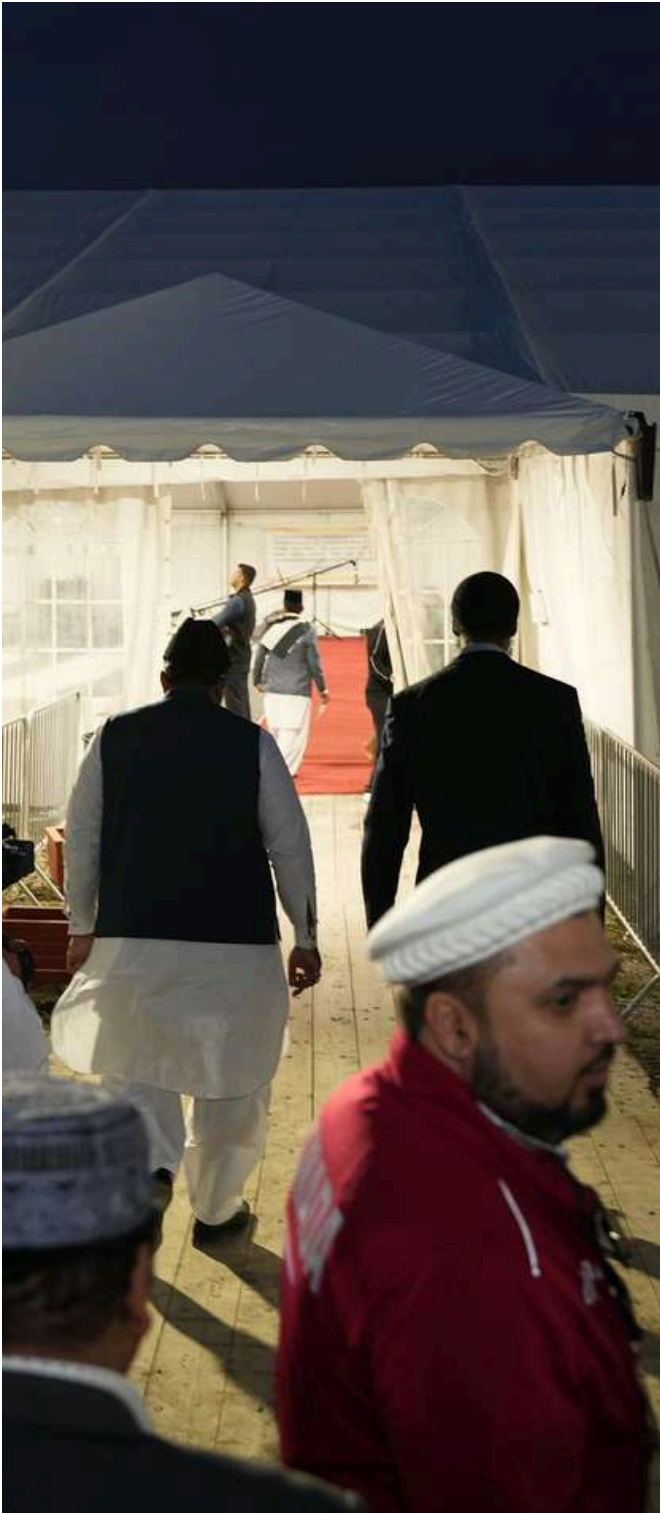
By the grace of Allah, Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada (MKAC) and Majlis Atfalul Ahmadiyya Canada (MAAC) held their National Ijtima on August 23, 24, and 25 at the Baitul Islam Mosque Complex in Maple, Ontario. Huzoor (AA) appointed respected Naib Amir and Missionary Incharge USA, Azhar Haneef Sahib as his representative.





Over 15 marquees were set up across 20 acres of land for this unique experience. On August 22, an inspection of the Ijtima Gah preparation was conducted by Huzoor (AA)'s representative, reviewing all areas of the site. He was joined by Sadr Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada, Tahir Ahmed Sahib.



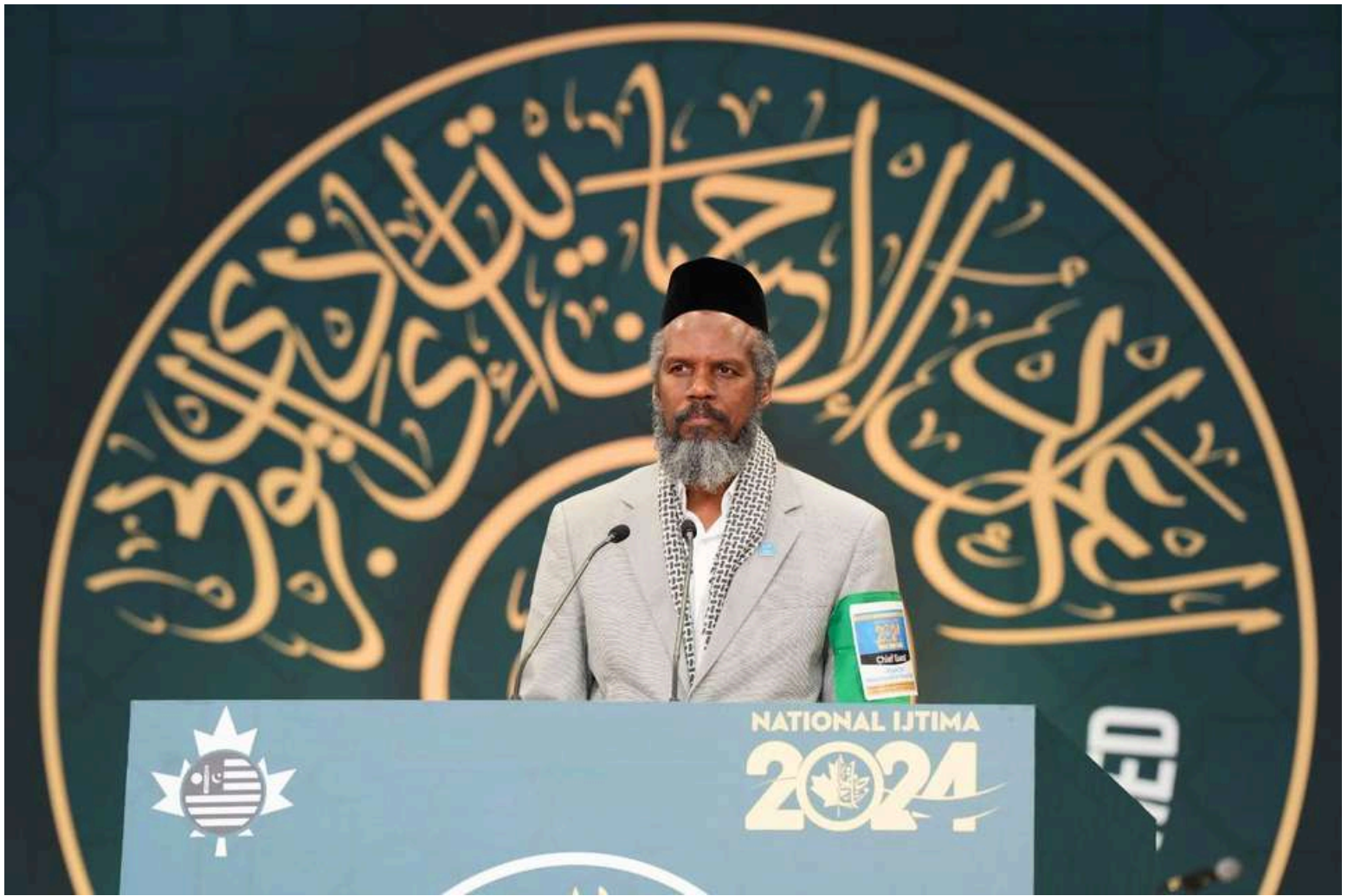


After the walkthrough and Maghrib & Isha' prayers, Maulana sahib gave an inspirational address on how one should perform their duties. He highlighted the importance of each and every duty and how they all come together to conduct such events at the highest level of quality. The session ended with silent prayers.



The First day of Ijtima commenced with congregational Tahajjud and Fajr prayers in Baitul Islam Mosque as well as in the main marquee. The opening session started at 2:30 pm with the raising of Liwa-e-Khuddam flag. The Formal session started with recitation of The Holy Quran, followed by Khuddamul Ahmadiyya pledge and poem.

Amir Jama'at Canada, Lal Khan Malik sahib, read out a special message from Huzoor (AA). He was followed by Huzoor (AA)'s representative who gave his opening remarks, in which he reiterated the message from Huzoor (AA) about Huqooq-ul-Ibad.



After the opening session, academic and sports competitions commenced. Concurrently, multiple other activities were organized to keep Khuddam engaged. A Hub Marquee had different recreational activities. Another marquee, had different workshops organized covering a wide variety of topics.



26 food stalls offered multiple tasty food options. Another marquee was home to four distinct exhibitions. These included

- Majlis Ansar Sultanul Qalam (MASQ) writing booth
- “Faith under siege” by International Human Rights Desk
- “A very interesting Huqooq-ul-Ibad Experience” by Humanity First
- The Review of Religions

These exhibits were visited by over 750 individuals. A bookstore was also set up where many of MKAC publications were placed for sale, with over 1,000 individuals visiting the store.

A special sitting with Huzoor (AA)’s representative was arranged for the following groups:

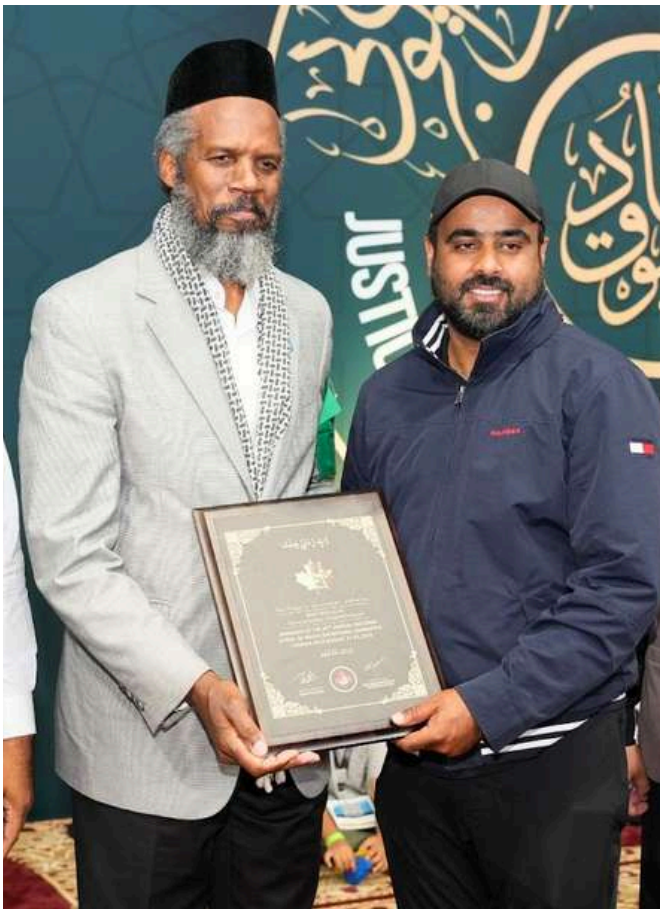
- Pan-African Ahmadiyya Muslim Association (PAAMA) Khuddam
- Arab Khuddam.

Two workshops were held on managing finances and Techniques for Effective Public Speaking and Presentation. Likewise, two outdoor stage sessions were held on the topics of Exploration of the Existence of God and The Psychology & Impact of Marriage.

Sports and academic competitions were followed by dinner and prayers. Next was an evening question/answer session attended by over 550 individuals. The panel included National Amir Jama`at Canada, Naib Amir Canada Sohail Sharma sahib, Sadr MKAC. This was the last item of day one.



Day two commenced with congregational Tahajjud and Fajr prayers. Next, address by Huzoor (AA) to ladies in Jalsa Germany was broadcasted live in the Main Marquee. This was followed by breakfast. Sports and Academic competitions resumed after breakfast. A session of Atfal was held with Huzoor (AA)'s representative lasting until lunch.



After lunch, Prize distribution ceremony was held for 2nd and 3rd place holders. Next were Zuhr and Asr prayers, followed by the second session of Ijtima. Sadr MKAC addressed Khuddam on the topic of "Faith Inspiring Incidences of Acceptance of Prayers". He was followed by National Amir Canada, who read out the message by Huzoor (AA).



After this, sports competitions continued. Multiple workshop sessions were held concurrently on a variety of topics. Likewise, multiple outdoor stage sessions were held on topics where Khuddam were also given a chance to ask questions.

A special sitting with Huzoor (AA)'s representative was arranged for the following groups:

1. NEW CONVERT KHUDDAM

2. NEW IMMIGRANT KHUDDAM

3. BANGLA KHUDDAM





A special dinner was held at 7:15 pm in which members of Jamaat-e-Ahmadiyya Canada's Amila, members of Majlis Ansarullah Canada's Amila, past Sadran of MKAC, Jamia teachers, missionaries and waqifeen were invited. Dinner was followed by Maghrib and Isha prayers.



This year a Tabarukat exhibition was setup on the third floor of Aiwan-e-Tahir. Various artifacts from the time of the Promised Messiah(AS), and all Khulafa were on display.



Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya Canada had a separate marquee for Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) for Khuddam and Atfal with special needs. This was established following the recommendation of Majlis-e-Shura as approved by Huzoor (AA). Seven individuals with special needs were accommodated and served.



A second night question/answer session was held. It lasted for more than an hour and ended with silent prayer.

The Third day commenced with Tahajjud prayer at the Baitul Islam Mosque, followed by Fajr prayer and Dars. Closing address of Huzoor (AA) to Jalsa Salana Germany was broadcasted live in the Ijtima Gah. All sports and academic competitions concluded before Zuhr and Asr prayers.

The Closing session started with recitation of The Holy Quran, followed by Khuddamul Ahmadiyya pledge, poem, Ijtima report, and prize distribution. After the prize distribution, Huzoor (AA)'s representative spoke on how to protect ourselves from the harmful effects of society and how Khilafat-e-Ahmadiyya acts as a shield. A group photo brought the session to an end.



MKAC Studios provided live streaming on all three days of the Ijtima. It was full of original content and studio sessions, with a total viewership of more than 10,000. Over 160 interviews were recorded during the Ijtima. A total of 11 individual videos, 3 promo videos, and over 7 YouTube shorts in promotion of the Ijtima were produced.

# NATIONAL MAJLIS AMILA OF KHUDDAM TRIP TO THE

# UK



On Sunday, April 14 2024, the National Amila of Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya Canada had the blessed opportunity to meet Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad, Khalifatul Masih V (AA) in a mulaqat, held at Islamabad, UK. At the outset of the mulaqat, Huzoor (AA) conveyed his salaam, and led everyone in silent prayer.

Huzoor (AA) then asked who among them does not understand Urdu. A khadim of Mauritian origin said he is serving as Muavin Sadr and added that he helps his father in the family business as a profession. Huzoor(AA) then asked if he speaks French, Creole, and English, to which he replied in the affirmative. He expressed that he only understands Urdu slightly and added that the more he serves in the Jamaat, the more he is picking up the language.





Touseef Ahmad Sahib, Mohtamim Atfal, reported that there are 2576 Atfal. Regarding their level of participation, he mentioned that around 1,000 attend classes regularly. Amir Mahmood Rana Sahib, Mohtamim Tarbiyat, reported that there are 7,600 Khuddam. Huzoor(AA) asked how many are regular in Jamaat activities. Amir Mahmood Rana Sahib replied that the attendance in the ijtimas is over 50%. He reported further details about the ijtimas and their locations.

It was noted that the practice of the five daily prayers could see increased participation among the members, who were significantly lacking in this regard. Hearing this, Huzoor(AA) said that the Promised Messiah(AS) said, "A religion in which there is no worship, is no religion." During the time of the Holy Prophet(SA), some asked to be excused from Salat. The Holy Prophet(SA) replied that a religion without worship is truly not a religion.



"The training of khuddam involves ensuring that 100% of them are accustomed to prayer." If they cannot pray in congregation at the mosque, they should do so at home, at the very least. It is for this reason that certain khuddam become associated with other negative behaviours. Herein lies the challenge of tarbiyat. Huzoor(AA) explained that if this aspect is not tended to, then all of them will be wasted. Huzoor(AA) then told them to make a tarbiyat plan. Huzoor(AA) said that this task cannot be accomplished alone. "A team should be formed in all areas." He added that they should utilise good khuddam to also help in the tarbiyat of the other khuddam.

Nabil Mirza Sahib, Mohtamim Additional Tarbiyat Baraye Rishta Nata, reported that sessions were conducted with parents in all regions to discuss the challenges faced by khuddam. Huzoor(AA) addressed, emphasizing the need for a coordinated plan involving both Lajna and Ansar regarding tarbiyat. He stressed the importance of everyone working together. After this, Huzoor(AA) discussed various budgetary matters with Mubashar Ahmad Sahib, Mohtamim Maal, and Muhammad Ansar Bajwa Sahib, Additional Mohtamim Maal.

Adnan Mangla Sahib, Mohtamim Ishaat, reported that this year's goal is to publish 12 editions of An-Nida. And he added that they have published five so far. Speaking with Muhammad Salman Majid Sahib, Mohtamim Sehat-e-Jismani, Huzoor(AA) asked him what games he plays. He replied that he plays basketball and volleyball. Upon hearing this, Huzoor(AA) asked him to stand to see his height. Huzoor(AA) then asked if he plays regularly, to which he replied affirmatively, adding that he did not play during Ramadan but usually plays twice a week. Huzoor(AA) then jokingly remarked, "I see. So all this weight you gained during Ramadan?" Huzoor(AA) then asked how many khuddam exercise regularly. Muhammad Salman Majid Sahib replied that 1,503 were regular. Upon hearing that 73% of khuddam give chanda, Huzoor(AA) drew a comparison between the chanda and the significantly lower percentage of those who offer salat, as per the collected data.

He emphasised the need to prioritise salat, stating that if khuddam focused on offering salat, the chanda would naturally follow. Huzoor(AA) said they should devise a plan to establish a team dedicated to encouraging khuddam to offer salat with the same fervour as they are encouraged to give chanda. Zuhaib Ahmad Sb, Mohtamim Khidmat-e-Khalq, reported that they funded charities, conducted 25 charity runs, and collected \$400,000. He mentioned that they also organise charity walks and added that last year they held a charity dinner, to which many contributed.



Muhammad Ansar Sahib, Mohtamim Muqami, reported that there are 1533 khuddam in the Muqami area. Regarding khuddam who are in need of tarbiyat, Huzoor (AA) asked if they are implementing any tarbiyat plans to safeguard them and others around them. Huzoor(AA) said that to safeguard the youth from the ills of society, “a comprehensive plan should be made.”

Farukh Tahir Sahib, Muavin Sadr Waqf-e-Nau, reported that there are a total of 2456 boys, out of which around 800-900 are khuddam. Alluding to the Waqf-e-Nau atfal, Huzoor(AA) emphasised the importance of safeguarding them. Huzoor(AA) further mentioned that he gave a sermon in Canada in which he highlighted the essence of being a Waqf-e-Nau. Referring to that, Huzoor (AA) suggested extracting points and circulating reminders from it. “Instil within their hearts why they are waqifeen-e-nau and what its essence is.”

Shuaib Sadi Sahib, Muavin Sadr MKAC Studios, reported that they have their own studio’s equipped with a control room, and an editing room. He added that all recorded content is then uploaded to their YouTube channel. Hearing this, Huzoor(AA) said: “You have quite a number of khuddam members who have the potential to make some good programmes. So, you should try to make your own programmes of MTA standard.”

Next, Abrar Ahmad Kahlon Sahib, Muavin Sadr Ziafat, had the chance to speak with Huzoor(AA). Then, Waqas Naveed Sahib, Muavin Sadr Properties and Inventory, reported that Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya Canada has four properties, all located in Toronto. Basharat Ahmad Sahib, Chairman of Mahmood Institute, reported that Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya launched an online platform named Mahmood Institute, where they record religious knowledge courses.

Huzoor(AA) asked how many khuddam are benefiting from this, to which Basharat Ahmad Sahib replied that this is their first year. He said that in the past four months, they recorded 12 Tarteel-ul-Quran courses, 11 Tarjamatul Quran courses, and three basic Arabic lessons. Following this, Tahir Mahmood Sahib, Chairman of Husn-e-Biyan, had the chance to speak with Huzoor(AA). Next, Hassan Sahid Sahib, Chairman Press & Media, had the chance to report to Huzoor(AA).

Speaking with Farhan Iqbal Sahib, Chairman of Majlis Ansar Sultan-ul-Qalam, Huzoor(AA) asked if he is a Nasir or a khadim, to which he replied that he still had one year left as a khadim. He reported that they have a total of 500 khuddam on their mailing list and added that around 25-30 actively wrote articles. Huzoor(AA) said, "Encourage those who are not active to become active." Mansoor Azeem Sahib, Muavin Sadr Wasiyyat, reported that 1645 khuddam are musis. Huzoor (AA) remarked that there are more musis than those who offer salat, questioning the purpose of being a musis in such a scenario. Concerning musis, Huzoor(AA) emphasised encouraging them to be regular in prayer and regular in reading the Holy Quran. "This is also the duty of the Wasiyyat Department."

Huzoor(AA) emphasised that one cannot simply expect forgiveness in the afterlife by only giving one-tenth of their income. Alluding to the total number of musis, Huzoor(AA) said that there should be at least 1600 individuals who are regular in offering their salat. Huzoor(AA) also addressed the qaideen, urging them to take note of this and make efforts accordingly.



Next, Zaki Ahmad Sahib, Regional Qaid for Western Calgary, had the opportunity to speak with Huzoor(AA). He reported that his duty consists of drawing people's attention towards offering prayers in congregation. Huzoor(AA) said, "Salat is the basic thing. At least 100% should be regular in offering their five daily prayers." While addressing the regional qaideen, Huzoor(AA) emphasised the importance of instilling the significance of salat and making them active in Jamaat related activities. Huzoor(AA) also inquired about the total number of khuddam in their respective regions.

Addressing Touseef Ahmad Rehan Sahib, Chairman of Social Media, Huzoor(AA) said to spread passages related to tarbiyat also. Next, Salman Rehan Sahib, Muavin Sadr Charity Walks, had the chance to present his report. Huzoor(AA) asked him if he also participated in walks and said, "You should also participate. If you lead by example, others will follow suit."

Khizr Kareem Sahib, Muavin Sadr Special Needs, reported that there are 59 khuddam and atfal with special needs. He mentioned that some atfal attend special schools and added that khuddam are at university levels and they have their own special needs. Following this, Sarmad Naveed Sahib, Muavin Sadr for Translations, had the opportunity to speak with Huzoor(AA). Huzoor (AA) also spoke with Ehsan Mahmood Sahib, Muavin Sadr for National Majlis-e-Amila Visits and Ijtima, and Haseeb Ahmad Sahib, Muavin Sadr IT.

Speaking with Musawir Ahmad Khan Sahib, Mohtamim Tahrik-e-Jadid, Huzoor(AA) asked him how many khuddam participated in this scheme. He reported that last year, 5,400 khuddam participated. Upon hearing this, Huzoor(AA) remarked, "That's 75%." He added that at least this many should also be offering salat.

Zargham Nasir Sahib, Mohtamim Sanat-o-Tijarat, reported that this year they are focusing on courses to improve the skills of the khuddam. While speaking with the Mohtamim Tarbiyat Nau-Mubai'een, Huzoor (AA) asked how many there are, to which he replied that there are 116 nau-mubai'een. Huzoor(AA) explained that they should involve them in their activities and integrate them into the mainstream. Huzoor(AA) added that after three years, their training should have reached a level where they can join the mainstream. Huzoor (AA) also emphasised the importance of salat.



Ijaz Chattha Sahib, Mohtamim Tajnid, reported that there are 7403 khuddam and added that this data was collected by them door-to-door. Mansoor Ahmad Sahib, Muhasib, was next to present his report and discussed budgetary matters.

Mir Nasir Syed Sahib, Mohtamim Talim, reported that this year's reading for khuddam consists of excerpts from The Essence of Islam, as per Huzoor'saa guidance. Jariullah Adnan Sahib, Mohtamim Tabligh, reported that this year, 25 individuals joined Islam Ahmadiyyat. He reported that out of the 25, 21 had converted after reading literature through the Jamaat. Zishan Iqbal Sahib, Mohtamim Umur-e-Tulaba, reported that there are 374 university-going students out of 2,014 students. Additionally, he mentioned that there are also some who are pursuing master's degrees.

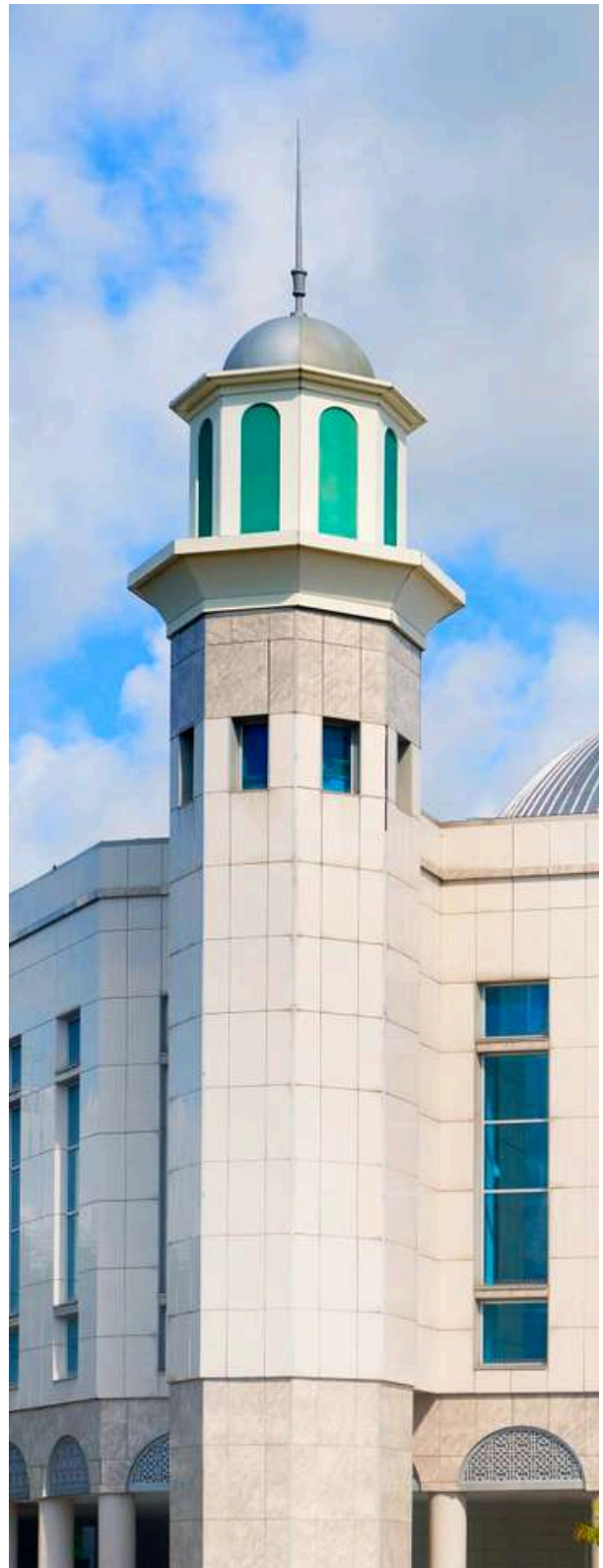
Speaking with Sultan Mubashar Sahib, Mohtamim Umumi, Huzoor(AA) emphasised that khuddam should be performing duties to safeguard mosques. Khalid Hassan Sahib, Mohtamim Waqar-e-Amal, reported that Waqar-e-Amal sessions were held in mosques and prayer centres. Then, Hamid Basil Ahmad Sahib, Abdul Noor Abid Sahib, Ayaz Warraich Sahib, Sabahul Zafar Sahib, and Iftekhar Ahmad Sahib all reported that they are serving as Naib Sadran. Huzoor(AA) then turned towards Sadr Sahib and expressed that he had gained the relevant information he needed and had guided them in various matters. Huzoor(AA) mentioned that the guidance he had provided throughout the meeting, if implemented, would suffice. Huzoor(AA) once again reiterated the importance of encouraging the khuddam to offer salat. Thereafter, Hazrat Amirul Momineen(AA) extended salaam to everyone and the meeting came to an end.

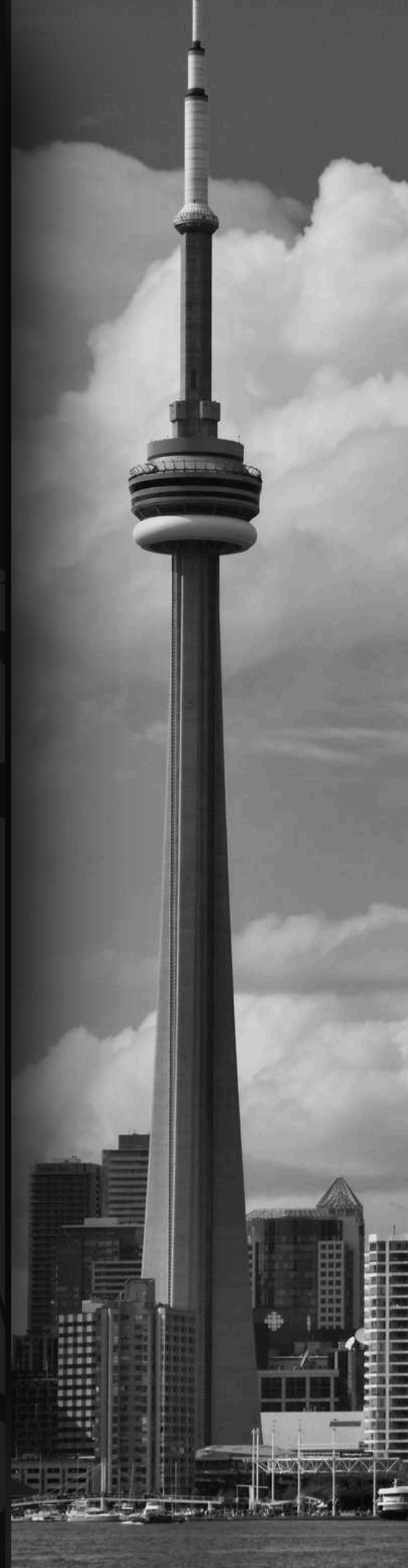

## CONFERENCE REPORT

# FAJR 40

By the Grace of Allah MKAC launched the Fajr 40 Campaign between December 1st 2023 and Jan 10th 2024, in order to inculcate the habit in Khuddam of offering Fajr prayer in congregation at the Mosque or local Namaz Centers across the country.

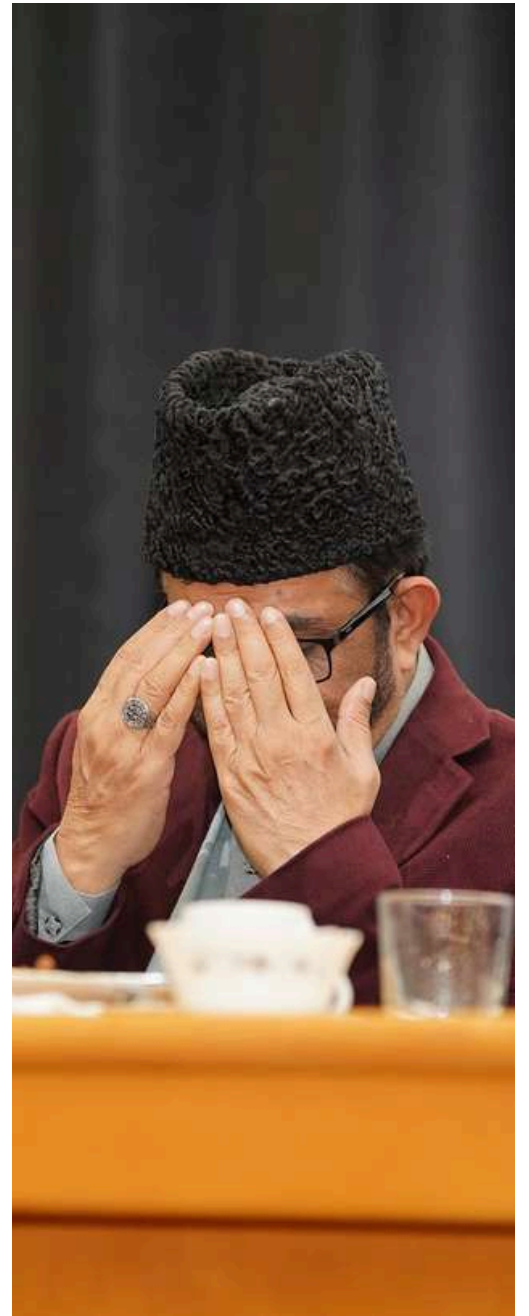


Adequate provisions were made to ensure physical accessibility within the venue. Furthermore, the SEND Accommodation house had private live-streaming and spaces available for family members to accompany their respective family member. There were also a variety of games and activities along with food arrangements to ensure that the space itself catered to their every need.

Sign language interpreters were available to facilitate effective communication for participants with hearing impairments. Trained volunteers offered assistance and guidance to participants with intellectual disabilities, ensuring their comprehension and engagement throughout the event. We had a one fully licensed and trained Physician at the accommodation house at all times to ensure safety of the participants. By the Grace of Allah there were no safety concerns.

- One of the highlights of the event was the incorporation of innovative features to enhance accessibility:
- Closed Captioning: Live captioning was integrated into the live stream, enabling participants with hearing impairments to follow along with the proceedings.
- Descriptive Audio: Descriptive audio narration was provided alongside the livestream, offering detailed audio descriptions of visual elements for participants with visual impairments.





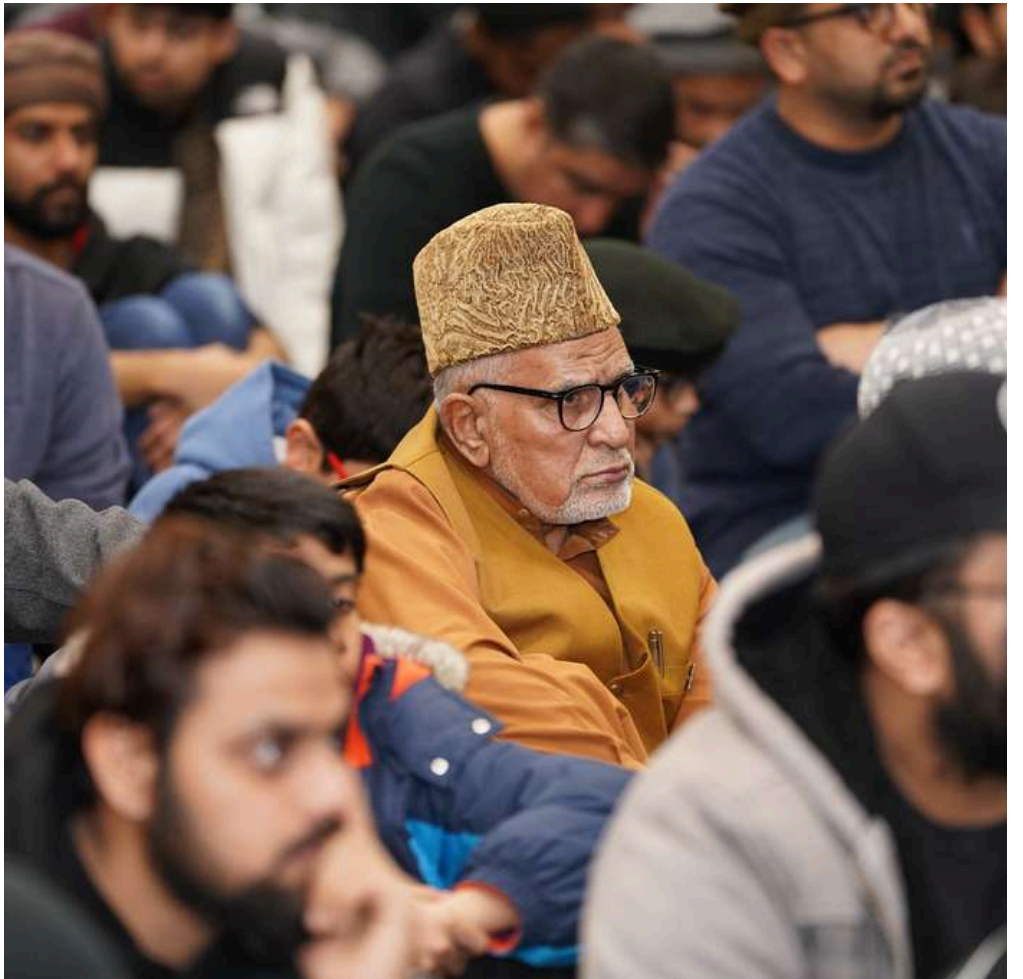




Feedback from participants and attendees overwhelmingly highlighted the positive impact of the SEND Accommodation Space. Many expressed gratitude for the inclusive approach, noting that it facilitated their full participation and enjoyment of the event. The initiative also raised awareness about the importance of accessibility and inclusion within the community.

These special members were also taken to the exhibitions and were included in the entire proceedings of Jalsa Khilafat to their utmost capacity. 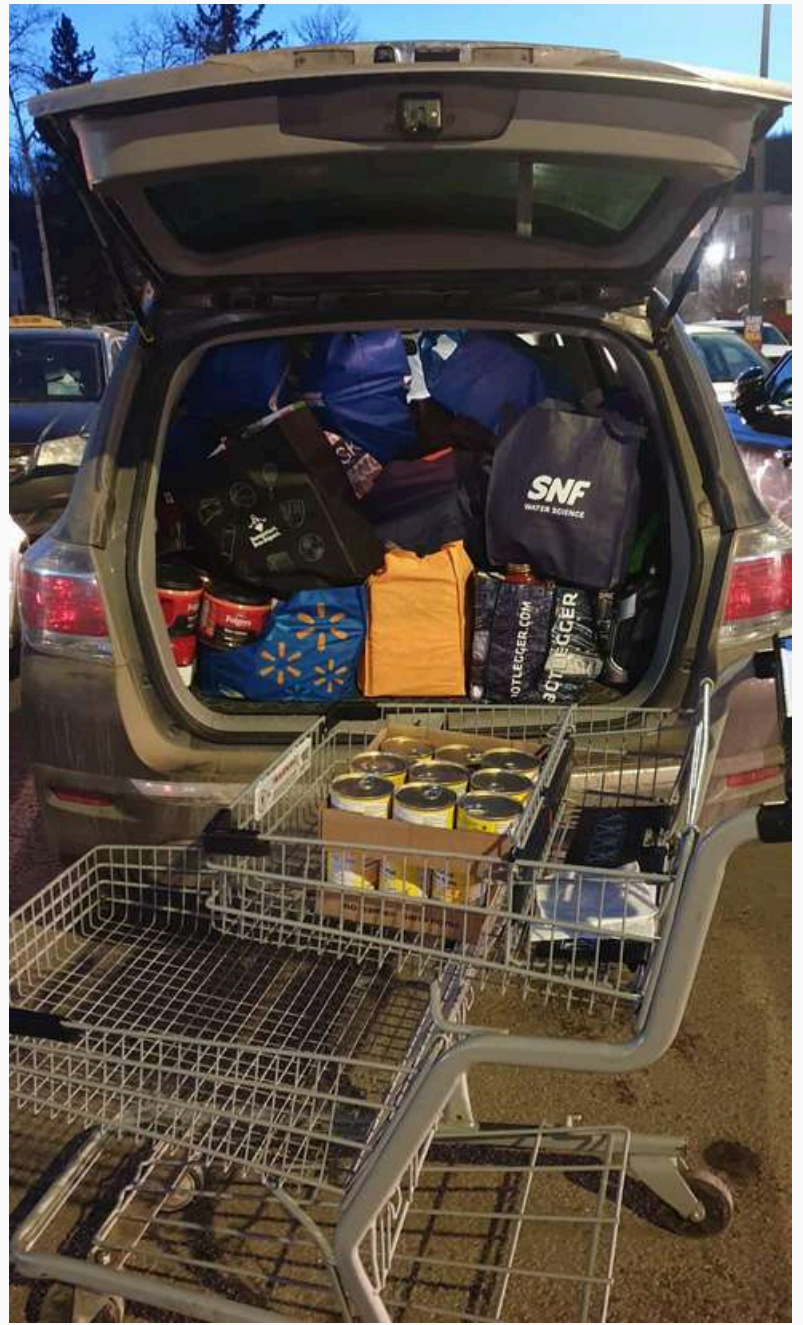

# PARLIAMENT HILL

## VOICES FOR PEACE EVENT

In light of the current state of affairs in the Middle East beloved Huzoor (aa) launched a global campaign titled "Voices For Peace". A campaign aimed at establishing a ceasefire and to become the voice of the innocent victims of an oppressive regime. On December 4th 2023, Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada held an event in Parliament hill Ottawa.

The event was attended by Members of Parliament, the Palestinian Ambassador and members of Khuddamul Ahmadiyya. Several news outlets also attended to record and report on the program. Internally, the program was covered by MKAC studios.



The highlights of the session included video clips of Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad, Khalifatul Masih V (aa). These clips were taken from his recent Friday sermons and other clips aimed at tackling conflicts and establishing world peace.



Sadr Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada, Tahir Ahmad Sahib spoke about Huzoor (aba) being the Global Ambassador of Peace. In addition, there were several presentations conducted by Murabbian. Murabbi Musleh Shanboor Sahib gave an emotional presentation on the current state of Gaza. Murabbi Farhan Iqbal Sahib presented on Islam and Human Rights.

Murabbi Naveed Mangla Sahib spoke on the contribution of Hazrat Musleh Mau'ud (ra) and Chaudhry Sir Zafrullah Khan (ra) Sahibs work for the Palestinian cause. The event was moderated by Salman Mangla, Naib Sadr Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Canada. Mona Abu Amara, the Chief Representative of the Palestinian General Delegation to Canada, delivered an important address appealing to politicians and decision makers to help the alarming situation in Palestine.

In total, the event was covered by 35 TV outlets, including CBC and Global News among others. 66 newspapers/online media also reported on the event. Notable media include Toronto Star, CTV News National, CP24 and more. Estimated reach to Canadians was approximately 7.5 million. In addition through MKAC Studios over 1000's of views on YouTube were accumulated. This event was also covered by MTA News. This event was held as the 1st such event to spearhead the global campaign in Canada. Similar programs were scheduled for January in various other cities around the country, Insha'Allah.

Similarly, On October 11th a dinner was also held to appreciate all efforts of all those khuddam who were involved in Sehat Jismani activities.

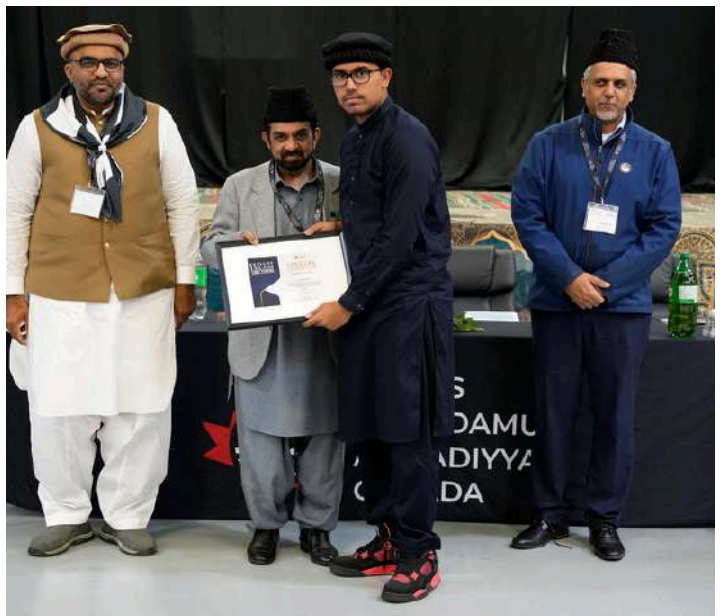

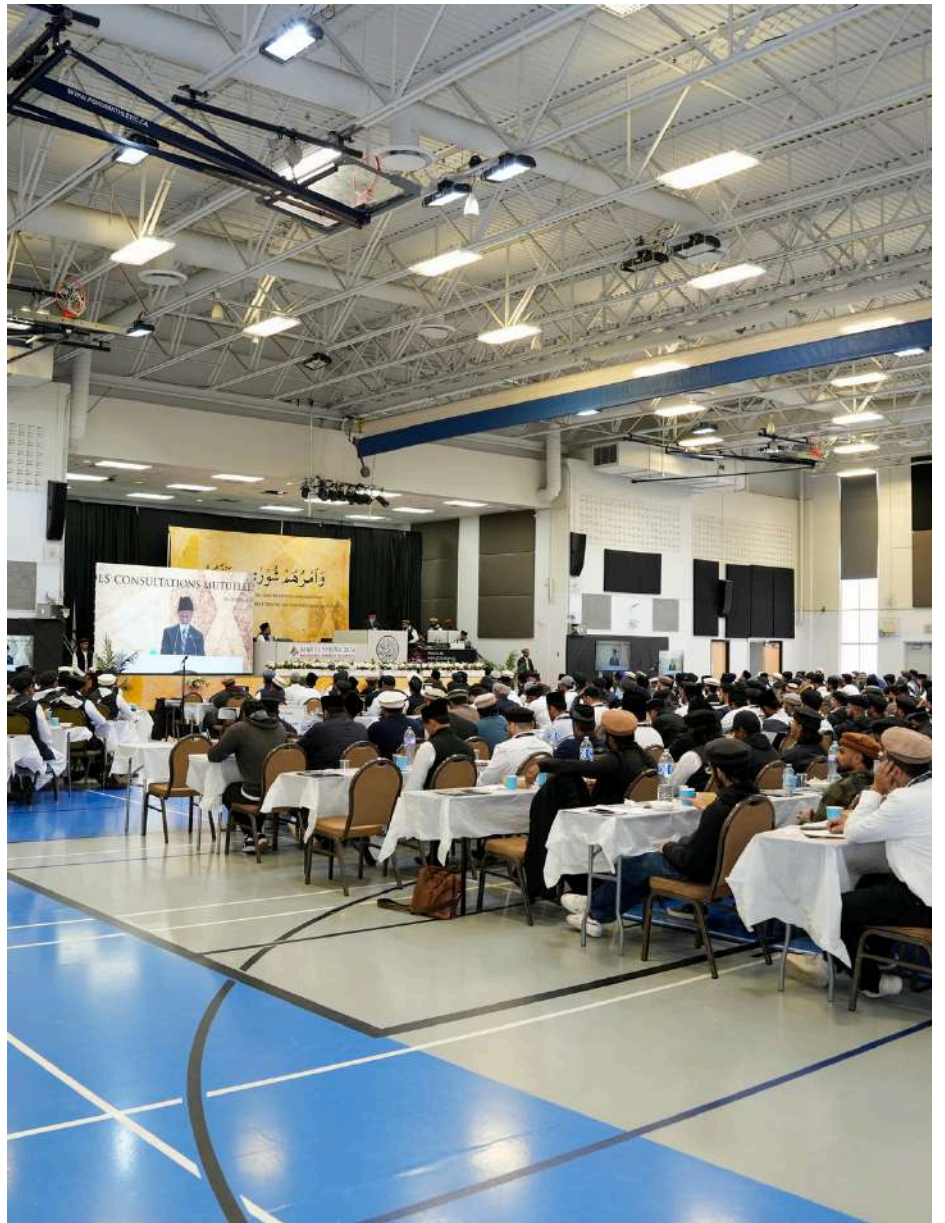
For those who came from distant regions, accommodation and transportation was arranged.

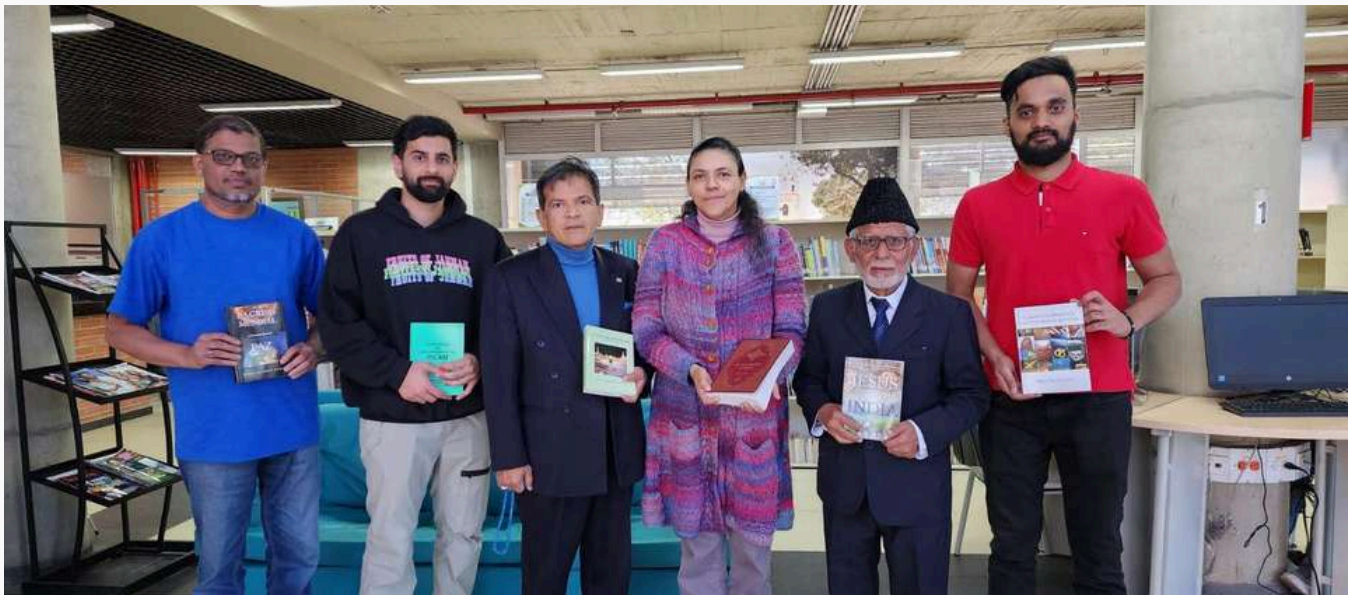
# WAQF 'ARDHI BELIZE
